Currently we ask that parents and carers continue to kiss and drop at the gate in the morning. We will have staff greeting our students until the end of Week 3 to support all our students and families.

Monday 1st February : Years 1-6

When you drop your child at school on Monday, you are welcome to walk into school with your child so they can show you where they will be learning in 2021. As part of our covid safety plan you must do the following:

- Enter via Illaroo Road main entrance or Walsh Crescent between 8:30 am and 8:45am.
- You **must** use the QRG code at the gate and record your attendance through the Services NSW app. This is for the Department of Health.
- Sign the visitor registration at the gate. A staff member will be there to help you. This will record your entry time.
- Please stay on site for a maximum of 10 minutes only.
- Maintain social distancing from other adults and children that are not a part of your family.
- Please **do not** enter our school site if you are unwell with any flu like symptoms or you have visited any high risk areas as identified by the Department of Health in the last 14 days.

This is an informal invitation as we recognise that our students love showing their parents where their new classroom is located. A formal Meet the Teacher session will be held for parents and carers on Wednesday 10th February 4:00pm-5:00pm where you can meet the teacher and view the classroom.
