Returning to School One Day per Week Supporting student wellbeing and academic growth.

Planning and communication are subject to change at any time based on government advice.

What you must bring:

- YOUR WORK PACK
- Drink bottle, crunch and sip and a packed recess and lunch. The canteen is not open yet and bubblers are out of action.

What your child will do at school on their allocated day:

Literacy and Numeracy

All teachers will review learning from previous week – review, discuss, feedback.

All teachers will set learning goals and outline key learning concepts for the following week's learning from home program.

Where applicable: change readers, additional learning support etc

Library and Music

Students will visit the library to return and borrow books.

Each fortnight, a music lesson with Mr Dunstan.

Wellbeing

A strong focus on wellbeing and connection activities for students.

Physical Activity

A sport activity will take place each afternoon.

What if my child must come to school on additional/different days?

- 4 additional teachers have been engaged to support students who *must* come to school on days not allocated to their class. Learning will be supervised and they will complete their workpacks.
- Your child will work with their class teacher on the scheduled day only. If they attend school on other days (eg you want to send siblings together), they may not meet with their own teacher.

I want to send all my children on the one day.

- 70% of families who responded to the survey indicated they wanted classes to return on the same day.
- Parents wishing to send siblings together must contact the school to discuss with Mrs Piggott or Miss Brooks. Call 4421 0422.

What about supporting Learning from Home?

- When Phase 1 is implemented, teachers must balance face to face and online learning.
- Learning Frameworks and additional activities will still be uploaded.
- When your child is at school on their planned day, no online support is provided. They are face to face.
- On the other 4 days, teachers will be checking for messages throughout the day, when they are able.
- Online support will be a maximum 1 hour per day. This is flexible.
- Teachers will respond to student or parent questions as soon as practically possible.

Physical Space:

- Double classroom spaces have been allocated to each class to support social distancing. Classes with more than 30 students will take advantage of outdoor space as well. This may not be your child's usual room.
- The hall and single classrooms will be used for supervision for additional children present. Limited access to technology applies as priority must go to the return to school schedule.

Can I come into the school with my child?

• No. Until further notice, please kiss and drop at the gate. All children are to move to the COLA/oval in the morning.
